BUSINESS

MEMBERS RESOLUTIONS

To consider, and if thought fit, pass Resolutions 1 to 8 below as Ordinary Resolutions. Resolutions 1 to 8 are Member Resolutions, notice of which has been given to the Club in accordance with S 249N of the Corporations Act :

- 1. <u>**Resolution One:**</u> That Alvin Chai be removed as a Director and the President of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.
- 2. **<u>Resolution Two:</u>** That Robert Poynting, having consented to act as a Director, be appointed as a Director and the President of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.
- 3. <u>**Resolution Three:**</u> That Craig Collie be removed as a Director and the Treasurer of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.
- 4. **<u>Resolution Four:</u>** That Gavin Harris, having consented to act as a Director, be appointed as a Director and the Treasurer of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.
- 5. **<u>Resolution Five:</u>** That Keith Brough be removed as a Director and the Vice-Captain of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.
- 6. <u>Resolution Six:</u> That Anthony Fehon, having consented to act as a director, be appointed as a Director and the Vice-Captain of Strathfield Golf Club effective immediately on the passing of this Resolution.

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS 1 to 8

In order to be passed, Ordinary Resolutions require the approval of at least 50% of Members present and entitled to vote.

The Members who have requisitioned this General Meeting, have requested that the statement which is attached as Appendix A be brought to the notice of Members.

In response, the Board of Directors and those individual Directors Alvin Chai, Craig Collie, Keith Brough and Bruce Adcock referred to in resolutions 1, 3, 5 and 7 have requested that the statements which are attached as Appendix B be brought to the notice of Members.

GENERAL BUSINESS

9. Resolution Nine:

That with effect from the General Meeting of the Club held on 24 June 2022 and pursuant to Article 13(b)(iv) of the Constitution, the Members hereby consent for an amount of up to \$337,000 to be released from the cash assets of the Adjusted Corpus for capital expenditure as outlined in the explanatory notes.

In order to be passed, this resolution requires a membership vote in favour of the resolution by at least two-thirds of majority of votes cast by Members who are entitled to vote.

EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR ORDINARY RESOLUTION 9

Due to the extraordinary wet weather of March and April 2022 and the adverse effects that these rains have had on the golf course, the Board of Directors request access to Corpus funds to address the issues. Immediate improvements to the golf course due to flood damage, drainage works and associated civil works involving significant expenditure are required.

Bunker Sand

The majority of the golf course bunkers are in extremely poor condition and require a significant top up of new sand.

Irrigation Satellite Boxes

Satellite boxes used to control irrigation on important parts of the course were destroyed by flooding from the Cooks River and need replacement. Flood damage of the satellite boxes is not covered by our insurance.

Fairways/Approaches/Rough

Holes 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 need soil preparation and turfing carried out. The majority of areas are fairly straight forward to prepare and lay turf. Holes such as 7, 8, 9 and 18 require large scale soil preparation using a rotary hoe and a tractor mounted excavator to remove and bury rocks that are present in the soil profile. Bare patches are an on-going issue on the golf course but made worse by recent rains with water lying on the course and killing off further areas of grass.

Drainage Holes 1, 9 and 18

Drainage improvements on holes 1, 9 and 18 are shown in the course works diagram below and require the following works.

- Installing pits and surface drainage (holes 1, 9 and 18).
- Pruning and removal Eucalyptus trees along the fence line of hole 9.
- Installing a new water pit in the adjacent carpark to capture rain waters prior to stormwater run-off across the fairways of holes 9 and 18.
- Install a service path along the fence line of hole 9. •
